

YOU ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN PEMBERTON'S 51st ANNUAL WATER CARNIVAL!

Dear Residents, Organizations and Businesses:

We are inviting you to participate in Pemberton Township's most historic event - the 51st Annual Water Carnival! It will be held on Saturday, July 13th on Mirror Lake with land-based events at Mirror Lake Beach and Reflections Park. The rain date is scheduled for Sunday, July 14th.

Pre-event activities will be held at Mirror Lake Beach from 4 pm to 7 pm. Activities include open swim, water-based and land-based inflatable rides, live DJ, food, contests and games for all ages!

Main event Festivities will begin at 6 pm with vendors, entertainment and music at Mirror Lake Beach (Clubhouse Road, Browns Mills) and Reflections Park (Lakehurst Road & South Lakeshore Drive, Browns Mills). The parade of floats will begin at 8:00 pm on Mirror Lake. The event will conclude with a spectacular fireworks display.

This event is designed to be an entertaining, community-spirited day for all participants, residents and local organizations. Building a float for the water may seem like a daunting task, but all it takes is a little patience, creativity, determination and spirit! In fact, we are hosting two "How to Build a Float" classes at Country Lakes Clubhouse on May 16th and at the BMIA Building on June 12th at 7 pm. Take this quick 1½ hour class to learn the basics behind building a float with canoes or kayaks!

There are two categories that float participants can register/compete under – Organization/Business and Family/ Individual. Thanks to generous contributions from corporate sponsors, cash prizes will be awarded to the overall float winner and 1st & 2nd winners in each of the two categories. All registered float participants/builders will receive a commemorative gift for participation.

If you would like to be an important part of Pemberton's history, please complete the attached form and mail it back **as soon as possible, but no later than Wednesday, July 10th.** We promise your entry will be kept top secret! Receiving your completed float registration on time will help to make coordination of the event much easier. Please be sure to include a brief story about your float (5 sentences max), information about your business, family or organization and/or any other information that we can talk about during the event (and on Channel 19). Please also include your music on a cd or memory stick prior to the date of the event.

2019 Pemberton Township Water Carnival Rules and Regulations

- The Water Carnival will be held at Mirror Lake Beach on Saturday, July 13th with the Parade of Floats beginning at 8 pm. <u>The rain date is Sunday, July 14th.</u>
- 2. All participants must fill out the attached registration form. Deadline to enter: July 10th
- 3. A float must be constructed on a boat, one canoe, or two canoes. Paddlers, gas motor (only day we are allowed) or electric motor may supply the moving force. Canoes may not be longer than seventeen feet.
- 4. Do not overlook balance! Heaviest objects should be carefully placed on the platform to provide adequate weight distribution.
- 5. All floats must be constructed and decorated so that they will be visible on the right side (shoreline) when traveling counter-clockwise around the lake.
- 6. All floats must report to the H-dock (to the left of the lifeguard building on Mirror Lake Beach Clubhouse Road, Browns Mills) at 6 pm. Each float will be given a number that will be displayed on the right side of the float. All floats will follow the numerical order assigned. Staff will be on hand to direct you.
- 7. Each entrant is responsible for the safety of his/her float and participants. It is mandatory to have one life preserver on the float for each person. Participants on the float who are under the age of 18 must be wearing a life preserver while on the float.
- 8. If you plan on using music as part of your theme, you must submit a CD or memory stick to the Recreation Department by July 10th.
- 9. Large backdrops or other flat surfaces become sails in the slightest wind. Since some wind should be anticipated, attention should be given to the stability of the float.
- 10. Maintain twenty feet between floats.
- 11. Please make every attempt to pass the shorelines and dam so that all spectators can enjoy your float! There will be four visible buoys to help guide you along the best and safest path for all viewers to see your float.
- 12. Each float **must have one representative remain at Mirror Lake Beach** for the Awards Ceremony. This is very important for the Channel 19 broadcast.
- 13. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- 14. Each participant must sign a Hold Harmless Agreement (attached).
