Keep Halloween decorations away from open flames, light bulbs and heaters.

It's easy for decorations like cornstalks and crepe paper to catch on fire. Keep exits clear of decorations, so nothing blocks a way out.



Use flashlights or battery-operated candles for Halloween decorations.

They are safer than candles and using them can prevent kids' costumes from catching on fire.



Fireplace Safety Tips




Have chimneys and vents cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional at least once a year.



Use your fireplace safely.

Always use a metal or heat-tempered glass screen when using your fireplace.



Install and test carbon monoxide (CO) alarms at least once a month.

CO is called the "invisible killer" because it's a colorless, odorless, poisonous gas. Breathing in CO at high levels can be fatal.
