TOWNSHIP OF PEMBERTON ORDINANCE NO. 7–2017

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEMBERTON

IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the governing body of the Township of Pemberton, County of Burlington, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

All previously adopted Ordinances establishing all employee and elected official's salaries, compensation and benefits are hereby repealed except that Chapter 38 of the Code of the Township of Pemberton, as may be amended from time to time, shall be saved from repeal.

ARTICLE I. ESTABLISHMENT OF SALARIES.

ARTICLE II.

The Chief of Police shall not be entitled to any longevity pay, clothing and weapons allowance.

ARTICLE III. REPEALER/INCONSISTENCY/EFFECTIVE DATE.

Any and all ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistencies, hereby repealed.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2017 following passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
