AGREEMENT ENTERED AS CONDITION TO ISSUANCE OF ROAD OPENING PERMIT, The permittee, as a condition to issuance of the road opening permit herein, hereby agrees that any facilities, pipes, poles or other object(s) to be installed within the Township's right-of-way pursuant to the permit shall be promptly relocated at the permittee's expense, as required by the Township of Pemberton, its officials, and/or its engineer, to accommodate the installation of Township facilities. In the event that permittee fails to promptly undertake such relocation, the Township may undertake the relocation and charge the cost of same to permittee, including all costs associated with collection. This agreement shall be binding upon all successors interests to permittee.
